#### **About this form**

Please use this form to change official ownership of a pet you are selling or giving away. Please submit it to your local council.

Pet owners must be over 18 years of age to legally own a cat or dog in NSW.

This form does not register a pet — give council a completed Pet Registration (R2) form and pay the fee to officially register your pet.

Please fill out this form in black ink and in BLOCK LETTERS.

#### Information for new owners

Change of owner is the first step in completing registration of your new pet.

The person who has sold or given this pet to you is responsible for submitting this form to council. They should give you a copy for your records.

Council will contact you once the Change of ownership has been processed.

If a registration payment for this pet is pending, you will receive a Record of Identification Information. Use this to complete registration by submitting it to council together with a completed and signed Pet Registration R2 form and the registration fee.

If registration has been paid by the previous owner, council will send you a Certificate of Registration. No further action is required.

If the person fails to give the form to council and change ownership into your name, you can use your signed copy to process the change.

## Information for those selling or giving away a pet

It is your responsibility as a breeder or former owner of a pet to complete and sign this form and give it to your local council. You must do this within 14 days of selling or giving away the pet away. Please give the new owner a copy of the completed form for their records.

#### **Privacy information**

Only authorised people can access the information provided on this form, and only to enforce the *Companion Animals Act 1998*.

If you are concerned that disclosure of your information could jeopardise the safety of you or your family, you may request that these details be suppressed. Please contact any NSW local council for more information.
