

Restricted or dangerous dog annual permit fees

Dog owners can use this form to pay the annual permit fee for dogs declared to be dangerous or restricted, as required under the *Companion Animals Act 1998*. If you own a restricted dog and it is declared to be dangerous, you must pay both annual permit fees using this form.

This form does not register a pet – give council a completed Pet registration (R2) form and pay the fee to officially register your pet

You must be over 18 years of age to legally own a cat or dog in NSW.

Information for owners

Permits are valid for 12 months from the date of issue.

It is an offence to sell, give away, advertise for sale or transfer ownership of a dangerous or restricted dog (or one that is proposed to be dangerous or restricted). A maximum penalty of \$16,500 (150 penalty units) may apply.

Additional penalties may apply if you do not follow the control requirements outlined in the dangerous or restricted dog declaration. Please contact your local council for more information.

Personal hardship and surrender

There are options to surrender dogs declared to be dangerous or restricted if you are in a personal or financial position where you cannot care for the pet. Please contact your local council for more information.

Privacy information

Only authorised people can access the information provided on this form, and only to enforce the *Companion Animals Act 1998*.

If you are concerned that disclosure of your information could jeopardise the safety of you or your family, you may request that these details be suppressed. Please contact any NSW local council for more information.
